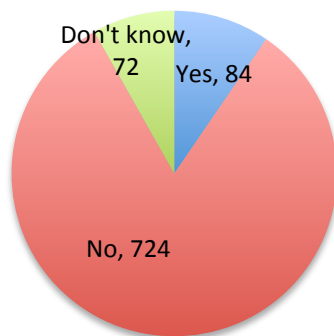

Q22 Would you apply for an allotment in Martlesham?



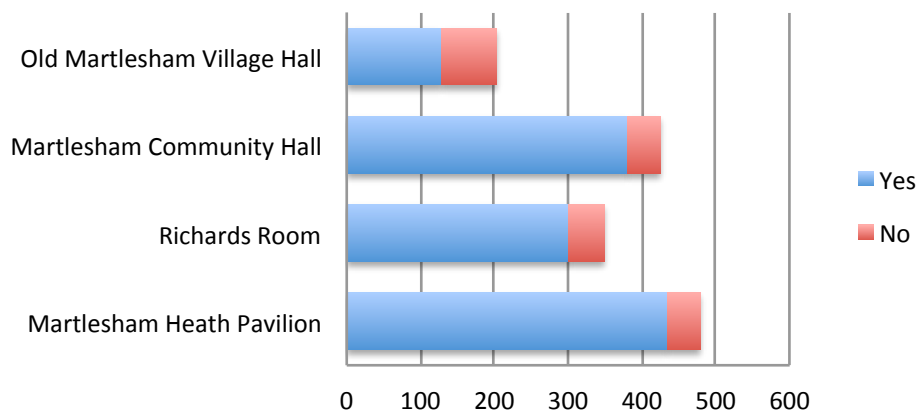
But more people felt they are good thing and should be provided. No clear trend as to where would be best. Depended on respondees location

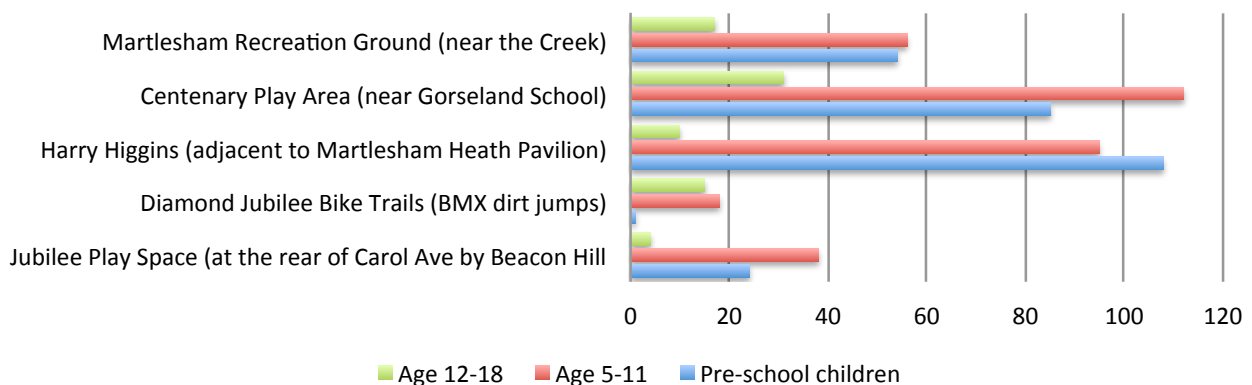
Q23 Do these village halls meet your needs?



The Old Martlesham village hall came in for most criticism

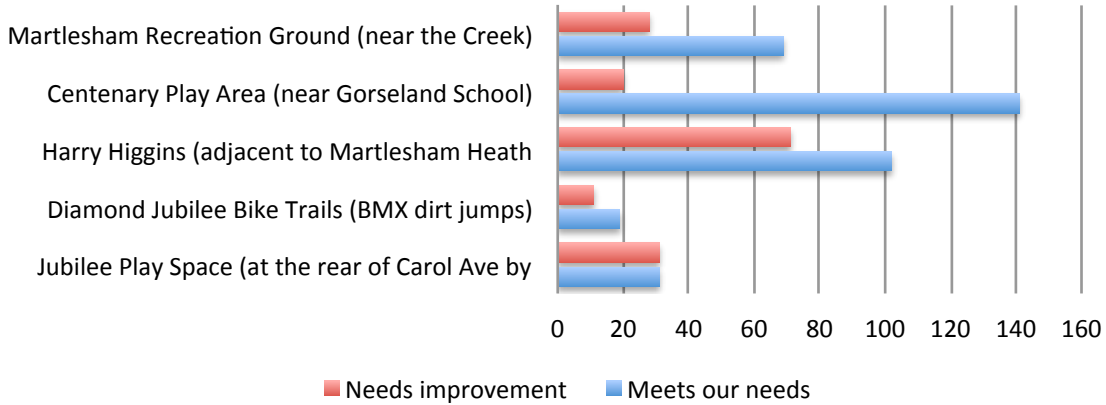

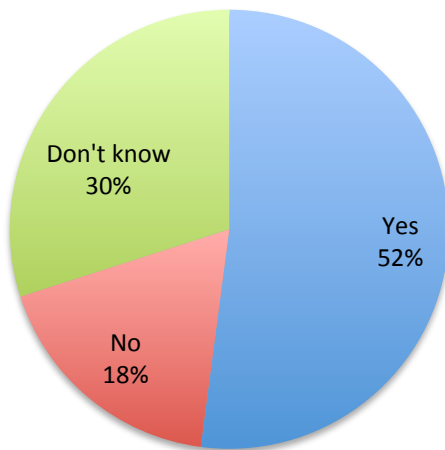

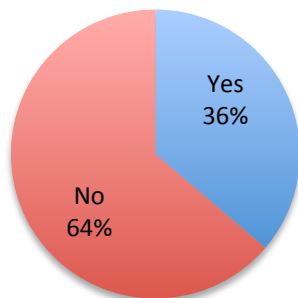

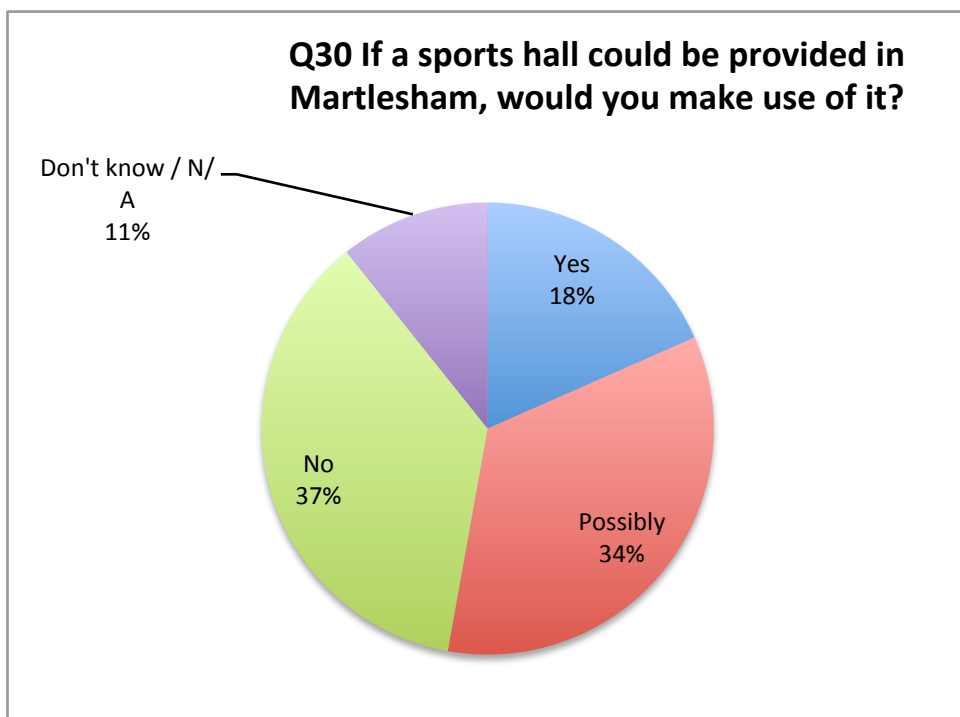

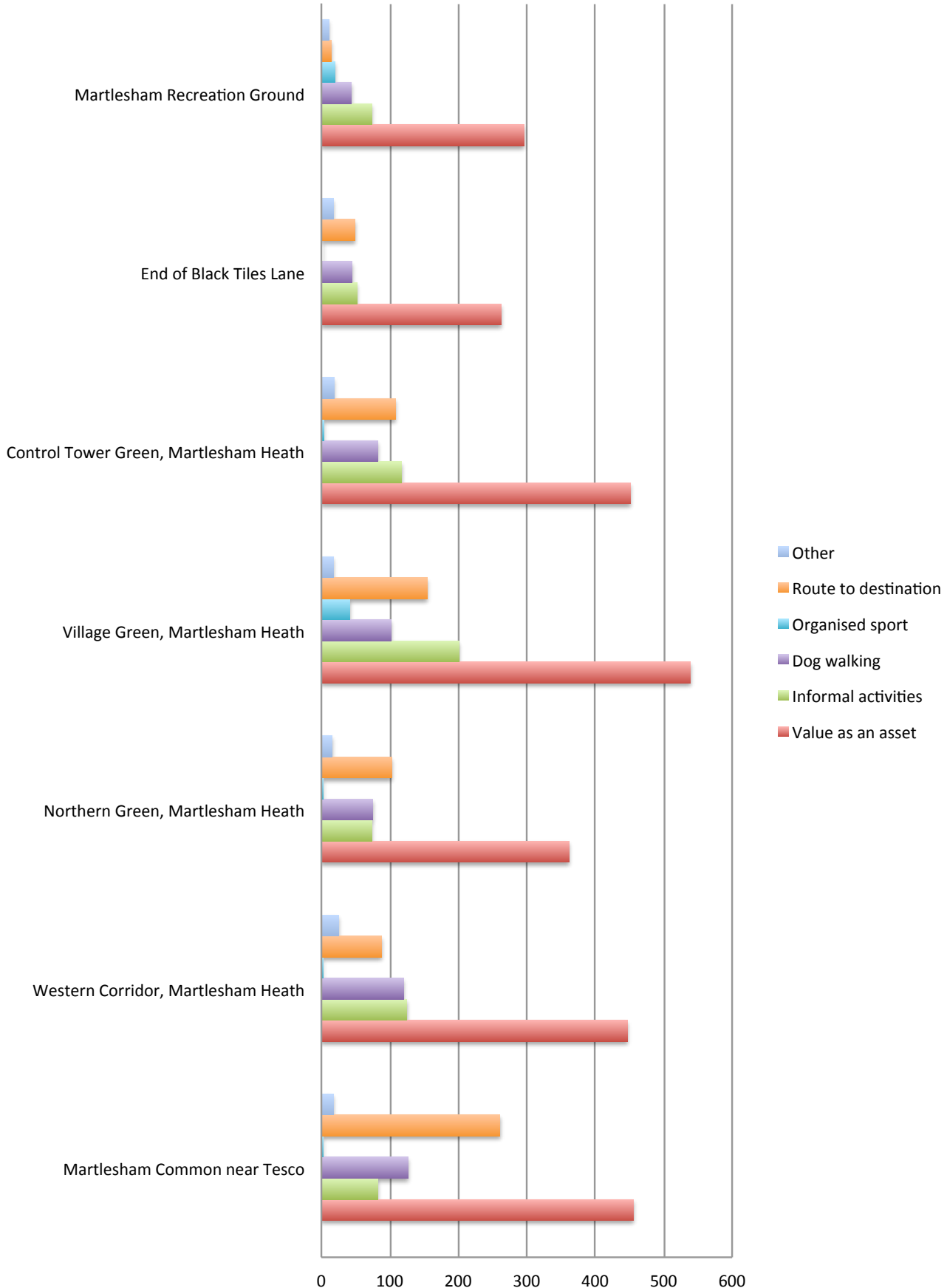

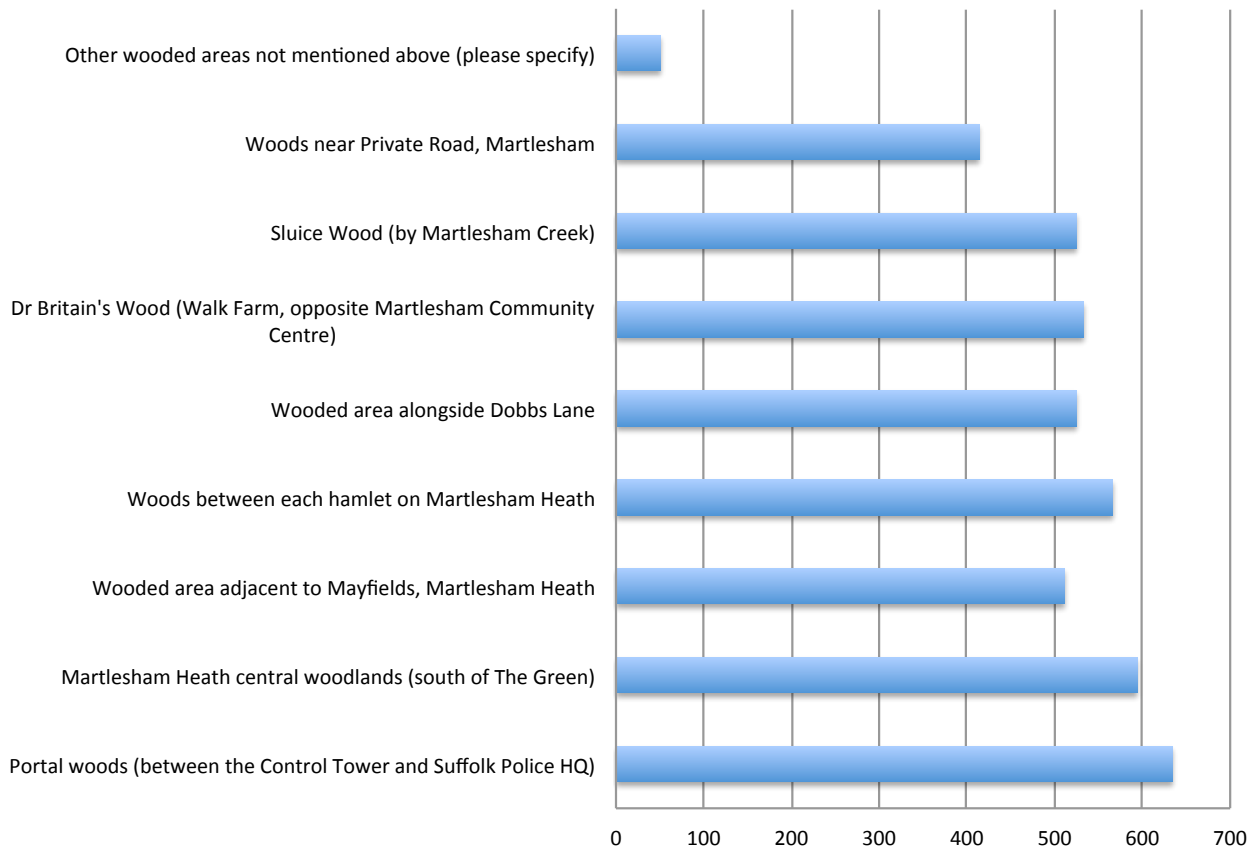

Q32 Which public open spaces do members of your household value and/or use?(Please tick all that apply)



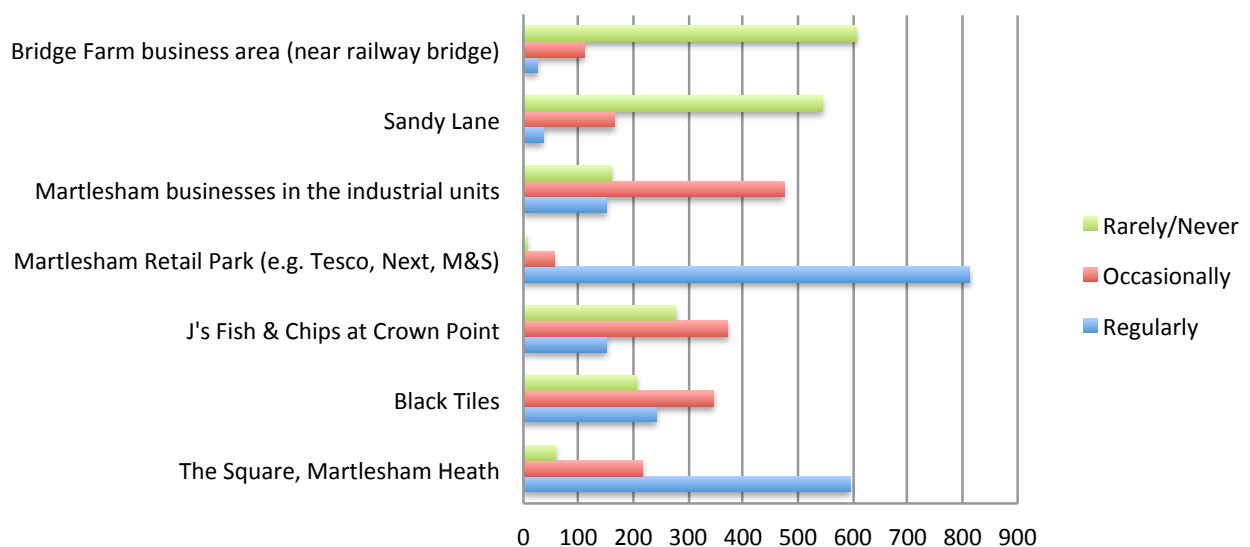

Q33 Which woodlands do members of your household value as an important asset for Martlesham?(Please tick all that apply)



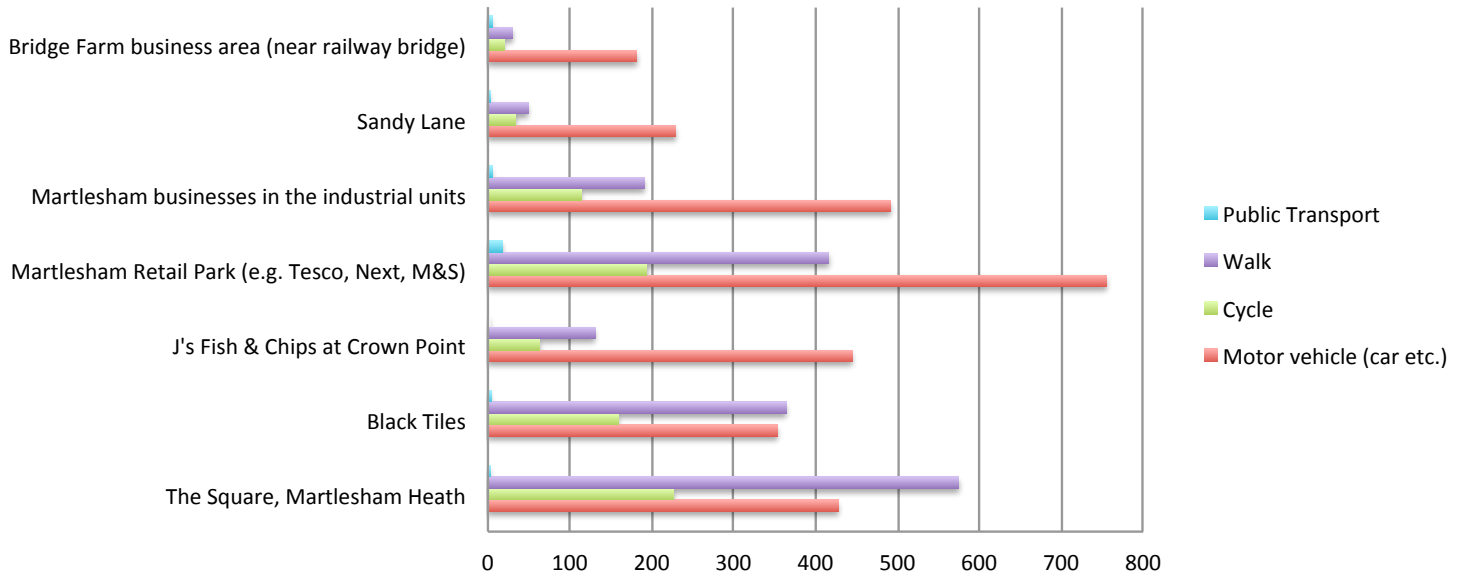

36. Do members of your household use the shops/retail businesses in these locations?



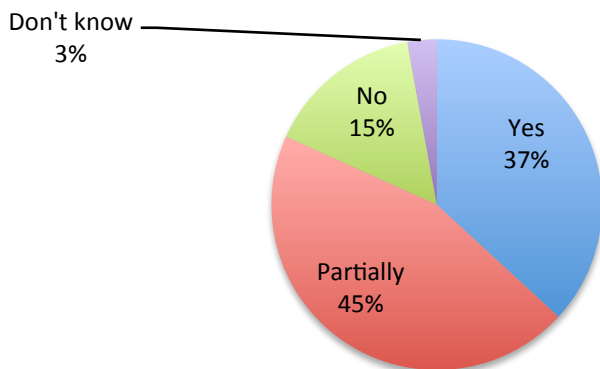
